

Tinka Shawl

Size: as you like (sample: 210 x 115 cm)

Material: as you like (sample: 202 Gramm Kauni Effect, Needles 5,5 mm), 1 marker for the middle stitch
You should use needles at least 2 needle size thicker than recommended for the yarn.

The first and last two stitches always k (R in the chart). Always k on RS and p on WS, except the middle stitch, it will has to be p on the right side.

Legend:

- ▼ : k1, yo, k1 into the same stitch
- ▲ : s1, k2tog, pssso
- ▴ : ssk
- ◀ : k2tog
- | : k stitch
- : yo
- R : edge stitches : k2 in right and wrong rows
- : p on the right side, k on the wrong side
- △ : slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, k 3rd stitch, slip the 2 slipped sts over
- ◀ : slip stitch, slip next stitch, k, pssso
- ▶ : k3tog

Instructions:

Cast on 5 stitches

R1 k2, yo, k1, yo k2

R2 k2, p1,k1, p1, k2

Continue with the Chart A, first the right side pattern, then the left side pattern (the Repeat is in the area marked red), always repeat row 11 to 18.

Starting the edge pattern: (right after a repeat of row 15 in Chart A)

In row 15 of Chart A you can see groups of 3 knit stitches next to each other. The number of these groups must be divisible by 4 when you start the edge pattern. Sample: 28 groups of triple k's, 343 sts

Now you continue by knitting several Charts within one row. **Attention:** The repeat of Chart B is 24 sts, the 25th stitch is only knitted once on either side of the shawl.

Arrangement of the Charts in a RS row: right outer edge, repeat, right inner edge, left inner edge, repeat, left outer edge. In row 22/WS you have to add one YO on each side of a peak to obtain sharper peaks.

After finishing row 22 of the edging knit 4 more rows (garter stsich).

Now bind off as follows:

Knotty –bind off - pattern: * k2tog, place thread in front of the left needle, slip the new stitch back onto the left needle with the thread still in front, place thread behind the left needle*

This Edge becomes elastic by itsself and doesn't need to be knitted very loosely.

Weave in ends.

Block the shawl, thereby draw out the peaks a bit more to obtain the shape.

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
