

## Lacy Blue Wristwarmers

The inspiration to the pattern comes from Anna Dalvi's wonderful Mystic Waters Shawl

### Finished Measurements:

Length: 21 cm

Hand circumference: 18 (tensed up to 25) cm

### Materials:

Sock yarn 4 ply, 210m/50g (you will need about 55 grams)

Recommended needle size 2.5 mm

Tapestry needle

You should use needles at least one size smaller than you usually use for this kind of yarn. If you want to obtain a narrower sock, you should use needles at least two sizes smaller. If you have real slim feet you should use 3-ply sock yarn. The cuff will get much wider than expected with this amount of stitches. You will see the final width after having knitted some rows in lace pattern only.

**Gauge:** 20 stitches and 40 rows Chart-pattern = 8 x 8 cm (28 stitches and 46 rows stockinette = 10 x 10 cm)
